



## *Dysplastic Nevus (atypical mole)*

The type of mole that you have is referred to as a dysplastic mole. This type of mole is considered by some authorities to be pre-malignant. It may have been more likely than a regular mole to turn into a melanoma (skin cancer). The pathologist reports that the entire mole was removed, so no further treatment is needed. As a preventative measure, you should check your skin monthly for any new or changing moles. A dermatologist should examine your skin at least once a year.
