



Griseofulvin Instructions

- Take this medication as directed, with or after a fatty meal (milk, ice cream, etc.)
- Do not take this medication if you are pregnant.
- Side effects:
 - Headaches (often improve in a few days, you may use tylenol)
 - Upset stomach
 - Possible decreased effectiveness of birth control pills. Use a second method of contraception if indicated. Discontinue this medication if you become pregnant.
 - May affect your liver or blood counts if taken for a long period of time. Some laboratory tests may be indicated if the medication is used for an extended period.
 - Do not drink alcohol while on this medication.
 - Possible increased sun sensitivity (use sunscreens).
 - Rash, confusion, and other side effects are less likely but possible. Notify your doctor if these or other problems occur.
- Notify your doctor that you are on Griseofulvin before any new medications are started.
